NATURAL WONDERS OF CHENGDU

Dujiangyan Scenic Area



The world's oldest irrigation system is located in China. Known as Dujiangyan, it is the only surviving monumental non-dam irrigation system from the ancient world. A remarkable feat of Chinese science and engineering, Dujiangyan was built more than 2,200 years ago. Today, the system continues to irrigate more than 668,700 hectares of farmland, control flooding, and supply water to over 50 cities across Sichuan Province.

Mount Qingcheng



Mount Qingcheng, located southwest of the Dujiangyan Irrigation System in Sichuan Province, is one of China's most renowned Taoist mountains. It is also a captivating scenic destination, covered with lush and verdant forests. Surrounded by numerous peaks and resembling a natural city, the mountain is known as "the most peaceful and secluded mountain under heaven," a title that reflects its tranquil atmosphere and evergreen landscapes.

Xiling Snow Mountain



Xiling Snow Mountain is a 4A-rated national scenic attraction and a habitat for giant pandas. Its main peak, Daxuetang, remains covered in snow throughout the year. The mountain features two distinct areas, with the rear area equipped with two cable cars. From Dayueping, visitors can enjoy spectacular views of the sea of clouds, sunrise, and the changing light between day and night. With scenery that transforms dramatically across the four seasons, it is the only mountainous scenic area near Chengdu where visitors can closely experience snow-capped peaks.

Panda Valley



Officially known as the Chengdu Giant Panda Breeding and Research Base Release Center – Original Ecological Valley Park, this expansive park covers more than 2,000 acres and is surrounded by bamboo forests and streams. Designed to simulate the natural habitat of wild pandas, it provides a home for pandas that have participated in release training. The park also features a small panda exhibition area and a science education museum. Offering experiences such as panda viewing, ecological education, and forest relaxation, it provides a serene environment for visitors to observe pandas in a tranquil setting.

Huanhua River Park



The only five-star free urban forest park in Chengdu, built along the Huanhua River water system, integrates natural wetlands and Du Fu's poetry culture. The areas of Caolang Lake and Bai Luozhou are spacious, and the Poetry Avenue inscribes poems from all dynasties of Sichuan. Pavilion and bamboo groves are scattered throughout the park.

Wangjiang Tower Park



A national cultural relic protection unit, the park featuring the most complete variety of bamboo species in China, was built to commemorate the talented woman of the Tang Dynasty, Xue Tao. The park is divided into a free bamboo forest area and a paid cultural relic area. The landmark, Chongli Pavilion (Wangjiang Tower), offers a panoramic view of the Jinjiang River when climbing up. It is accompanied by ancient sites such as Xue Tao Well and Poetic Composition Tower. The atmosphere is rich in ancient charm and it is a classical garden by the river in the urban area.

People's Park



Established in 1911, the park features the reflection of willow trees on the lake, and the century-old "Houming Tea House", where you can enjoy Gongbei tea. Remains include the Memorial Stone for the Protection of the Road during the Xinhai Revolution and the commemorative landscape of the Sichuan Army's Anti-Japanese War. The combination of urban gardens and authentic old Chengdu scenes allows you to experience the local slow-paced life and is a must-visit spot.
