Chengdu Giant Panda Breeding & Research Base



The world's largest research, breeding, and conservation centre for giant pandas, this 4A-rated scenic attraction is set amid lush greenery. It is home to the famous giant pandas Hua Hua and He Ye, as well as red pandas. Giant pandas are most active in the early morning, making it the best time for visitors to observe them. The park also features a panda education centre with exhibits on breeding, conservation, and wildlife protection. With its tranquil surroundings, it is one of Chengdu's most iconic attractions for experiencing China's national treasure. Advance online ticket reservations are required.

Chunxi Road



Established in 1924, this century-old street is the historic commercial heart of Chengdu. Its name is derived from the phrase, "All are bustling, as if ascending the Spring Terrace." The street is lined with trendy brands, traditional snack shops, and large shopping malls. At Zhongshan Square, visitors can see a bronze statue of Sun Yat-sen, while the nearby relief wall depicts the folk customs and everyday life of old Chengdu.

Taikoo Li



An open, low-density commercial district that seamlessly blends traditional Tibetan-style architecture with modern retail, this vibrant destination is also home to the historic Great Mercy Temple. The district is divided into two distinct zones: a bustling shopping area and a more relaxed leisure precinct. It features luxury brands, Michelin-starred restaurants, and creative boutiques. Its striking 3D naked-eye screens and the temple's iconic red walls have become some of Chengdu's most popular photo spots.

Dongjiaojiyi



This national 4A-rated industrial cultural and creative park was transformed from the former Hongguang Electron Tube Factory. It preserves industrial heritage features such as Soviet-style red-brick buildings, steam locomotives, and historic chimneys. The park is filled with colourful graffiti walls, live music venues, and creative retail shops, and regularly hosts exhibitions and live performances. Its celebrity handprint wall is a distinctive attraction. Open to the public free of charge, the park's retro industrial aesthetic makes it a popular destination for photography, nostalgic heritage tours, and contemporary leisure experiences.

Nine-Eyed Bridge



The iconic ancient-style covered bridge spanning the Jinjiang River features intricately layered eaves and elegant blue stone architecture. At dusk, the illuminated bridge casts stunning reflections across the river, creating one of Chengdu's most picturesque night views. Adjacent to the Hejiang Pavilion and the riverside bar district, the area offers folk music venues, riverside walking paths, and free public access throughout the day. Blending the charm of traditional architecture with the energy of the city's vibrant nightlife, it is a favourite destination for both sightseeing and evening strolls.
